HOW YOUR HOUSE CAN BE HELPFUL

6. Hold down excess noise, like loud music, taxi horns, yelling, etc....
7. Please park in designated parking places only. **Do not park on the grass.**
8. Look for opportunities to be part of your neighborhood:
 - Join the neighborhood watch
 - Attend picnics or other neighborhood functions
 - Help neighbors when you know they are in need of help
